224. CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY	
1. Purpose	The Board believes that the schools should help students learn to respect property and develop feelings of pride in community institutions
2. Authority	The Board charges each student in the schools of this district with responsibility for the proper care of school property and the school supplies and equipment entrusted to his/her use both within and outside of the school day.
SC 777	Students who willfully cause damage to school property shall be subject to disciplinary measures. Students and others who damage or deface school property may be prosecuted and punished under law. Parents and guardians of students shall be held accountable for student actions.
SC 1338	The Board may report to the appropriate juvenile authorities any student whose damage of school property has been serious or chronic in nature.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent shall develop procedures to implement this policy which include: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Rules for the safekeeping and accounting of textbooks, supplies, and equipment.2. Preparation of a schedule of fines for lost or damaged textbooks, supplies, and equipment.3. A report to the Board on the incidence of vandalism.
SC 109	<ol style="list-style-type: none">4. Which report shall include the number and kind of incident, the cost of vandalism to the district, and such related facts and comments as the Superintendent may wish to make.5. For purposes of the 1:1 iPad initiative, reference the student/parent handbook for detailed information on financial responsibility for repair / replacement of a lost or damaged iPad.
