## 703. SANITARY MANAGEMENT

1. Purpose

The Board recognizes that the health and physical well-being of the students of this district depend in large measure upon the cleanliness and sanitary conditions of the school premises.

2. Authority SC 701

The Board directs that a program of sanitary management be instituted in the schools and explained periodically to all staff members.

The Board directs that standards be maintained that meet the requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Health, Department of Labor & Industry and any local agency which has jurisdiction.

All the facilities of the district shall be regularly inspected for cleanliness and sanitation by the Manager of Properties and County Health Department.

3. Delegation of Responsibility

The Superintendent and the Supervisor of Build ings and Grounds shall develop and supervise a program for the cleanliness and sanitary management of the school buildings, school grounds and school equipment pursuant to statute, rules of the State Board, and regulations of the local and State Boards of Health and the Department of Labor & Industry.

Cleanliness of each school building shall be the responsibility of the Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds.

Teachers shall be responsible for the general condition of their classroom.

Principals periodically shall inspect facilities in the company of the foreman and report any conditions which may threaten the comfort, health or safety of occupants to the Superintendent.
