Shaler Area High School is a comprehensive high school that offers a wide variety of courses. Please review the contents of this course description booklet before making course selections and give serious consideration to those choices.

It is suggested that you review the recommended curriculum patterns on pages 10 & 11. These patterns explain the various course requirements for grades nine through twelve. A worksheet has been provided on page 9 to assist you in planning your schedule. All students are required to register for seven periods, with the exception of students enrolled in A.W. Beattie Career Center.

The nine-period day gives all students the opportunity to reach out and pursue their interests in elective areas such as art, music, business & information technology, family consumer science, technology education and S.T.E.A.M.. These Career Pathways are intended to push students beyond the typical criteria for acquiring a high school diploma.
