



Welcome to Kindergarten! We are so excited to get started! Below you will find a list of provided supplies, individual supplies for your student to bring to school, and appreciated optional donations. We look forward to a fun year of learning with the students.

Provided Supplies:

Pencils, crayons, folders, scissors, glue sticks and erasers will be supplied to each student and will be refreshed throughout the year. (Please keep all extras at home. Ex: markers, colored pencils, sharpeners, etc.)

Individual Supplies to Bring to School:

- Rest Mat – if you already have a rest mat from an older sibling that attended kindergarten, please feel free to reuse it.
 - Due to the size of our lockers, the mat must be **NO LARGER THAN 19x45 inches and 1 INCH THICK**. (Google “1-inch basic Kindermat.”) The mat should also be made of a wipeable surface, as we regularly wipe the mats to cut the spread of germs in the classroom. Please have your child bring a rest mat on or before the first day of school. **Be sure to label the mat with your child’s name**. (Please keep pillows, blankets, and “stuffedies” at home.)

- Reusable Water Bottle – Our classrooms get hot, so a personal water bottle will ensure your child stays hydrated throughout the day.
 - We have many spills in kindergarten, so please be sure your child’s water bottle has a secure flip or squirt top lid.
- Backpack
- Headphones (Information on headphones will be given once we learn which devices will be provided for kindergarten this year.)
- Small Packaged/Bagged Nut-free Snack (daily)
 - Please limit your child’s snack to one “easy to eat” item.
 - Drinks other than your child’s water bottle are not permitted at snack time.

OPTIONAL CLASSROOM DONATIONS

Our classroom will gladly accept any of the following items:

- Container of disinfectant wipes
- Boxes of tissues
- Packages of napkins (for snack time)
- Zip-top bags (any size)
- Roll of paper towels
- Package of hand/baby wipes (for messy projects)

First Grade Supply List

Your child will need to bring the following items with them for the start of their first grade year:

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 backpack (without wheels)
- 1 water bottle with sports cap (spill-proof!)
- 1 set of headphones in a labeled bag to be kept at school. Kids seem to prefer the over-the-ear headphones to ear buds. Please no wireless headphones.

All other supplies will be supplied by your child's teacher or requested in a letter towards the beginning of the year.

Welcome to second grade! Here is a list of supplies your student will need to begin second grade:

- backpack
- water bottle
- headphones
- fully charged school iPad

Donation of these supplies are always appreciated:

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- tissues

- band aids

Crayons, folders, scissors, glue, rulers and pencils will be provided at school. However, it is a good idea to have these supplies at home to use when needed throughout the year!

It's hard to believe the 2025 - 2026 school year is beginning! We look forward to working with your students. We just wanted to share a little information about 3rd grade.

The following is a list of supplies that your child will need to have daily at **SCHOOL**:

- Fully charged iPads
- Pencil box & sharpener that is covered to collect shavings.
- BLACK expo marker
- Monthly supply of pencils...not all at once, just make sure they have enough each month.
- Ear buds for their iPads. They must be **Bluetooth** or **wired USB-C headphones**.
- **We will provide them with crayons, notebooks, folders, markers, colored pencils, glue, scissors, and a ruler for use at school.**

The following is a list of supplies your child will need for **HOME**:

- Pencils, crayons, markers, colored pencils, glue sticks, scissors, ruler, and a pencil sharpener

Do **NOT** send in binders, notebooks, and/or folders, as there is not enough room in their desks or lockers.

If you would like to donate items for the classroom some suggestions are gallon and/or sandwich size Ziplock baggies, Kleenex, and Clorox wipes.

Since the core of our curriculum is taught during the morning, please make every effort to schedule any appointments that would pull your child out of school, during the afternoon. Third grade has their specials in the afternoon.
