Welcome to 3rd grade! Third grade is a year of exponential learning and growth! We are very excited and can't wait to see everyone. Many times, families like to prepare for the upcoming school year and often the sales are in July and August. Here are some items needed for the upcoming school year:

- Durable backpack (no wheels won't fit in lockers) Labeled with full name
- Lunch bag/Lunchbox- labeled with full name
- o NON SWEAT water bottle with full name
- 1 <u>soft shell nylon</u> PENCIL case, no larger than 8 in x 4 in. This should lay flat and fit
 easily inside of a desk. <u>Anything bigger OR hard case</u> will not be able to be used due to
 space and will be sent home.
- o 1 set of ear buds(headphones) and case (to stay in locker)
- o 1 Pair of scissors (Fiskars last the longest)
- 1 box of 8-12 COUNT <u>sharpened</u> colored pencils <u>OR</u> 1 box of 8-12 COUNT crayons/ Twistables (All 3 are not needed- ONLY ONE - others will be sent home)
- 1 box of thin coloring markers (8-12 count)
- o 2 Dry Erase Markers (black or blue) and eraser (an old clean sock will do)
