Under the direction of the Superintendent of Schools and High School Principal, the **Director of Athletics** is responsible for the leadership, organization, supervision, and promotion of all interscholastic athletic programs within the District. The Director ensures compliance with WPIAL, PIAA, and Title IX regulations; fosters student-athlete development; maintains high standards of safety and sportsmanship; and promotes a positive image of the District's athletic programs within the school community and the public at large.

The Director of Athletics provides strategic direction for the district's athletic programming, budgeting, and community engagement. This role oversees athletic facilities, event coordination, and staff supervision—including coaches, trainers, faculty managers, equipment staff, and fitness center personnel—ensuring excellence and equity across all programs. In collaboration with coaches and school leaders, the Director is responsible for implementing and sustaining high-quality, high-performing athletic programs that promote student success, teamwork, and character development.

This is a highly visible leadership position requiring exceptional communication, organizational, and relationship-building skills. The Director will work collaboratively with district administrators, coaches, families, and community partners to ensure that athletics continues to reflect the District's vision: "To engage all students in meaningful learning, empower them to reach their full potential, and inspire them to excel."

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Education, Sports Management, or a related field.
- Demonstrated experience in the administration of athletic programs.
- Knowledge of WPIAL, PIAA, and league regulations; Title IX compliance; and interscholastic athletic operations.

- Experience managing budgets, athletic contracts, and event scheduling.

- Demonstrated success in fundraising, sponsorship development, or community partnerships.
