General Notes:

1. Contactor responsible for verifying measurements.
2. Contractor to ensure proper fit and operation of all doors.
3. Contractor to remove any security systems hardware affected by this scope of work and turn over to school district to be re-installed.
4. Contractor is responsible for removing and disposing of all doors and frames.
5. Contractor is responsible for furnishing all labor, equipment, materials, and supplies to remove old doors and frames and install new, as specified.
6. Contractor responsible for cleaning work area when finished.
7. The Shaler Area School District reserves the right to select which areas will be done and whether the school district will do the installation or contract the work.
8. The main hookup to electric, mounting of the power supply, and new or existing card reader (if needed) is not part of the project. Contractor to use guide wire in frame for follow up mounting of access control on doors with access control.






