Welcome to Kindergarten! We are so excited to get started! Below you will find a list of needed supplies and appreciated optional donations. We look forward to a year of learning and fun with the students.

Provided Supplies:

Pencils, crayons, folders, scissors, glue sticks and erasers will be supplied to each student and will be refreshed throughout the year. (Please keep all extras at home. Ex: markers, colored pencils, sharpeners, etc.)

Individual Supplies to Purchase:

- **Rest Mat** – if you already have a rest mat from an older sibling that attended Kindergarten, please feel free to reuse it.
 - Due to the size of our lockers, the mat must be **NO LARGER THAN 19x45 inches and 1 INCH THICK. (1-inch basic Kindermat)** The mat should also be made of a wipeable surface, as we regularly wipe the mats to cut the spread of germs in the classroom. Please have your child bring a rest mat on or before the first day of school. Be sure to label the mat with your child's name. Please keep pillows and blankets at home.

- **Rest Mats can be purchased at the following locations:** Walmart, Amazon, and Target all carry rest mats.

- **Reusable Water Bottle** – we have lots of spills in kindergarten, so please be sure your child's water bottle has a secure flip or squirt top lid.
 - Our classrooms get very hot, so a personal water bottle will ensure your child stays hydrated throughout the day.
- **Backpack**
- **Headphones (for your child to use with school iPad)**
- **Small Packaged/Bagged Nut-free Snack (daily)**
 - Please limit your child's snack to one "easy to eat" item.
 - Drinks other than your child's water bottle are not permitted at snack time.

First Grade Supply List

Your child will need to bring the following items with them for the start of their first grade year:

- 3 boxes of Kleenex
- 1 backpack (without wheels)
- 1 water bottle with sports cap (spill-proof!)
- 1 set of headphones in a labeled bag to be kept at school. Kids seem to prefer the over-the-ear headphones to ear buds. Please, no wireless headphones.

All other supplies will be supplied by your child's teacher or requested in a letter towards the beginning of the year.

Welcome to second grade! Here is a list of supplies your student will need to begin second grade:

- backpack
- water bottle
- headphones
- fully charged school iPad

Donation of these supplies are always appreciated:

- tissues
- bleach wipes
- band aids
- baggies...sandwich and gallon sized

Crayons, folders, scissors, glue, rulers and pencils will be provided at school. However, it is a good idea to have these supplies at home to use when needed throughout the year!

Welcome to 3rd grade! Third grade is a year of great learning adventures! Below are the supplies your child will need for third grade. PLEASE NOTE: Your child will receive a new iPad this year. The new iPads can only support this type of headphone: **wired USB-C headphones**, and the new iPads **do not support** traditional 3.5 mm headphone jacks.

- 1 plastic pencil case, approximately 8in. x 5in.
- 1 set of headphones to keep at school: Wired USB-C

We use headphones daily and they are not supplied by the school.

- 12 pencils- **sharpened**, plus *more to keep at home* as back-up. We do not supply pencils. (The average 3rd grader uses 2 pencils a week.) **Please write your child's name on the pencils with a permanent marker.**
- 1 hand-held pencil sharpener with cover to contain shavings
- 1 dry-erase marker- black ink only
- 1 or 2 containers of Clorox disinfecting wipes
- 1 or 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 box of sandwich-size baggies with closure- please bring these *if your last name ends in A-K*
- 1 box of gallon-size baggies with closure- please bring these *if your last name ends in L-R*
- 1 Roll of paper towels *if your last name ends in S-Z*

Every year, students will bring other items to school. We have very small desks and have no room for extra supplies. Please keep all other items at home.

We will supply the folders, notebooks, crayons, colored pencils, and composition books that are needed. We cannot stress the importance of having enough pencils for the year. We are also always looking for donations of new Play-doh, beads, building blocks, and indoor recess games or toys. Thank you so much for your support.
